



2020 S&C USA Elite Select Woodside Qualifier Rules

Tournament Rules

1. NO NEW INNING will start after 1 Hour and 30 minutes.
2. The tournament director has the right to shorten games in the event of bad weather or delays that would cause us to run out of daylight.
3. If bracket games are tied after (7) innings or the time limit the International Tie-Breaker rule will be used. Teams will start with the last batter of the previous inning on 2nd base with no-outs.
4. POOL GAMES CAN END IN A TIE. If the game is tied after the time limit has expired the game will end in a tie. If there is still time left after 7 innings they will play one inning of International Tie-Breaker. Bracket or Championship games will play International Tie Breaker after the time limit or 7 innings.
5. Home team will be determined by a coin flip in all games throughout the tournament.
6. Teams must use USA Elite Select/USSSA Batting Rules or bat roster. Teams batting roster may use the last out to run for the pitchers or catchers. <https://www.usssa.com/usaes/rules> or teams can choose to bat their entire line-up or use DP Flex.
7. RUN RULES FOR TOURNAMENT- 10 runs after 4 innings, 8 runs after 5 innings & 6 runs after 6 innings.
8. All Championship games will still have a 90 minute time limit.
9. ALL BATS MUST HAVE A USSSA STAMP ON IT! THE BLUE GHOST BAT IS ILLEGAL FOR USSSA. 1st team offense the batter is out. 2nd Team Offense player and manager are ejected for game and next game.
10. ALL TEAMS MUST BE REGISTERED USSSA. Rosters must be on the site and ALL WAIVERS MUST BE SIGNED.
11. Once a team plays their 4 games they will not continue to play off for 3rd Place or 5th Place. The idea is to get them used to playing longer games (hopefully four 6 or 7 inning games instead of a bunch of 4 or 5 inning games).
